

IJEN (2d/1n): Eternal Blue-Fire

Day 1: Bali - Ferry Port - Banyuwangi / Bayuwangi Airport

We will pick you up from Bali airport or your hotel in Bali then drive to the most western tip of Bali to reach Gilimanuk ferry port upon arrival at the harbor, we will cross Bali strait that takes about one hour to reach Ketapang ferry port in Banyuwangi . Arrive in Bayuwangi drop to hotel for check in. Free program. You can also fly directly to Bayuwangi airport where our team will meet you.

Day 2: Ijen - Ferry Port - Bali

At around 01:00 am, our team will pick you up to start the adventure. On the way to Mount Ijen, we will pass through one of the few remaining rain forest on the island of Java with giant ferns, plants & big trees. Once arrive, we will start ascend slope of mount lien to reach peak of the crater and along the path, you can enjoy the stunning natural scenery. Later while waiting for sunrise at an altitude of 2386 meters we can see the infamous eternal blue fire dancing in front of our eyes. You can spot the sulfur mining workers go up and down into the crater through steep path on the edge of the crater with loads as heavy as 80 kilograms on their shoulders. Once the sun have gone up we will start to descend the slope of Mount Ijen until vehicles based. Breakfast en route at local restaurant then arrive back to hotel for packing and check out. Then drive back to Bali via Ferry Port and later in the evening arrive back in Bali.

Day 2: Ijen - Bayuwangi Airport

At around 01:00 am, our team will pick you up to start the adventure. On the way to Mount Ijen, we will pass through one of the few remaining rain forest on the island of Java with giant ferns, plants & big trees.
