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Luwuk Banggai (5D4N) : Relax Beach

Day 1 Makassar - Luwuk - Salakan (-/L/-)

Arrive at Luwuk Airport, where you will be welcomed by our local team and transferred for lunch at a local restaurant. After lunch, continue to the harbour and board the ferry to Salakan, the main town of Banggai Kepulauan and an important gateway to the surrounding islands, beaches, lakes, and coastal communities. The ferry crossing takes approximately 4 hours, and a private cabin will be arranged for a more comfortable journey. Arrive in Salakan in the evening then transfer to your accommodation for check in. Dinner will be served at a local restaurant then free program.

Day 2 Paisupok Lake - Paisubatango - Poganda Beach (B/L/-)

Early breakfast, then depart around 7:00 AM for Paisupok Lake, famous for its crystal-clear turquoise water, submerged tree trunks and peaceful forest setting. Small freshwater fish can often be seen through the exceptionally clear water, while dense tropical vegetation surrounds the lake. Enjoy time to swim, relax and take in the scenery. Continue to Paisubatango, a quiet lagoon surrounded by limestone, mangroves and lush greenery. The calm water and natural setting make it ideal for a short swim and light exploration. Lunch will be served en route or at a local restaurant. In the afternoon, proceed to Poganda Beach, known for its white sand, clear water and tropical coastal scenery. The shallow waters support small reef fish and coral life, making it suitable for swimming and light snorkeling. Return to Salakan in the evening. Free program.

Day 3 Mandel Beach - Pompon Beach - Bobilon Beach (B/L/-)

After breakfast, depart for a full day exploring some of Banggai's beautiful coastal scenery. Begin at Mandel Beach, where you can enjoy the peaceful shoreline, clear tropical water, and relaxed island atmosphere. Continue to Pompon Beach for more time by the sea, with opportunities to swim, take photos, and enjoy the natural surroundings. Lunch will be served en route or at a local spot. In the afternoon, proceed to Bobilon Beach for the final stop of the day. Spend time relaxing by the coast and taking in the scenery before returning to Salakan. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.



● Day 4 Salakan - Bonggan Village - Bajau Tribe - Luwuk (B/L/-)

Morning check out from the hotel and visit Bonggan Village, located only around 5 minutes from Salakan. The village is home to the Bajau community, often known as the Sea Gypsies, whose lives have traditionally been closely connected to the sea through fishing, boating, and coastal living. Spend time walking through the village, observing the wooden houses, boats, and everyday activities while learning about their relationship with the surrounding waters. Enjoy a special lunch with the villagers, featuring freshly prepared fish cooked in a traditional local style and served with sago, one of the staple foods of eastern Indonesia. The experience offers a closer look at Bajau hospitality, food traditions, and community life rather than simply visiting the village as a sightseeing stop. In the afternoon, transfer to the harbour and board the 4:00 PM ferry back to Luwuk. Upon arrival in Luwuk, transfer to the hotel for check-in, dinner in town and free program.

● Day 5 Piala Waterfall – Luwuk Airport (B/-/-)

After breakfast and check out from the hotel then depart for Piala Waterfall, one of Luwuk's most beautiful natural attractions. Hidden among lush tropical forest, the waterfall flows through several natural tiers into crystal-clear turquoise pools, creating a peaceful setting for a refreshing morning visit. Enjoy time to explore, take photographs, or swim in the cool natural pools before returning to Luwuk. After the visit, continue directly to Luwuk Airport for your onward flight in the afternoon.



Luwuk Banggai (6D5N) : Nature Paradise

Day 1 Makassar - Luwuk - Salakan (-/L/-)

Arrive at Luwuk Airport, where you will be welcomed by our local team and transferred for lunch at a local restaurant. Day 3 Mbuang Mbuang : Stingless Jellyfish Lake - Giant Clam - Liang Tadul (B/L/-)

At 7.00am depart for Mbuang-Mbuang to visit the Jellyfish Lake, a unique marine lake known for its population of harmless jellyfish. Enjoy the rare experience of swimming among them in calm, sheltered water surrounded by lush island scenery. Continue to the Giant Clam Area, where the clear shallow sea provides an opportunity to see impressive giant clams and colorful marine life beneath the surface. This is a good stop for swimming and snorkeling while appreciating the rich underwater ecosystem of Banggai. Later visit to Liang Tadul, a scenic coastal area known for its clear water, limestone surroundings, and peaceful natural atmosphere. Spend time exploring, swimming, and enjoying the landscape before returning to Salakan in the late afternoon. Free Program.

(Mbuang Mbuang is unavailable during August to September due to high waves)



● Day 4 Banggai Sea : Tanjung Gundul - Panjang Beach - Oyama Beach - Popisi Village (B/L/-)

Early departure from Salakan and transfer by road to Tobing, then continue by speedboat to Banggai Sea for a full-day island and coastal exploration. Begin at Tanjung Gundul, a scenic coastal point with open sea views, rocky shoreline, and clear blue water. Continue to Pantai Panjang, known for its long stretch of white sand and calm tropical atmosphere, perfect for a short walk, swim, or photo stop. Proceed to Pantai Oyama, another beautiful beach with clear water and a more secluded island feel. Lunch will be served during the excursion. In the afternoon, visit Popisi Village, home to a local Bajau community, where guests can observe traditional coastal life, wooden boats, and the community's close connection with the sea. Continue to Pantai Bobilon for the final beach stop of the day before returning by speedboat and road to Salakan in the evening. Free program.

● Day 5 Salakan - Bonggan Village - Bajau Tribe - Luwuk (B/L/-)

At around 9am check out from the hotel and visit Bonggan Village, located only around 5 minutes from Salakan.
