MOI TRIBE OF MALASIGI (3D2N)

Day 1 Sorong - Malasigi Village (-/L/D)

Pick up from hotel in Sorong or directly from the airport and in a 4WD vehicle for approximately 1.5 hours through the lush landscapes of Sorong Regency to reach Malasigi Village. Upon arrival, visitors will be warmly welcomed by the Moi Tribe with traditional songs and dances and accommodated in a simple yet authentic village house. In the afternoon, a guided 1–2 hour trek through the surrounding rainforest leads to the famous Birds of Paradise display grounds, where several species including the Lesser, King, Twelve-Wired, Magnificent, and Rifle Birds of Paradise can be observed from specially built towers or viewing blinds as they perform their remarkable courtship displays. Authentic meals during the stay are prepared by the women of the village, offering guests a genuine experience of local Moi Tribe hospitality.



Day 2 Moi Tribe (B/L/D)

Spend the day immersed in the pristine rainforest of Papua, far from the pace of modern life. Guided by local experts, you will explore jungle trails and enjoy birdwatching sessions at sunrise and in the late afternoon, the best times to observe the spectacular Birds of Paradise performing their courtship displays. Guests may also learn traditional fishing techniques from the Moi community and experience how fish is prepared and cooked using natural jungle ingredients and fire. Depending on weather and river conditions, optional activities may include visiting a nearby cave, relaxing in the river where warm water flows from a natural source, or further exploring the surrounding forest. In the afternoon back to the village, relax and free program.



Visit 3 Malasigi Village – Sorong (B/L/-)

On our final day in the rainforest, take the morning to enjoy the tranquil surroundings one last time, with an opportunity for a short forest walk to observe wildlife or simply appreciate the natural beauty of the jungle. In the afternoon, you will depart Malasigi Village and travel back to Sorong by 4WD vehicle through the rainforest. Upon arrival, you will be transferred to your hotel or straight to airport for the next destination.



RAINFOREST OF PARADISE (4D3N)

Day 1 Sorong – Malagufuk Village (-/L/D)

From Sorong, we will go into the rainforest toward the Klasow Valley. With 4WD will take you through the rugged forest road for approximately 1.5 hours then we will continue our adventure on foot with a 3 km walk along a boardwalk leading to Malagufuk Village. Porters will assist by carrying your bags to the village. Malagufuk is a small jungle settlement where local people stay while tending their gardens and transporting produce back to Sorong. Accommodation is in eco village located in the nature camping area. In the afternoon, there will be time to explore the surrounding lowland rainforest, which is known for its rich birdlife. With some luck, you may even encounter the impressive cassowary, the second-heaviest living bird, native to the tropical forests of New Guinea.



Day 2 Birds of Paradise (B/L/D)

At around 4:00 AM before sunrise, we will start a guided trek of approximately 1 hour uphill through the forest to reach the display tree of the Lesser Bird of Paradise (*Paradisaea Minor*). Along the way, you may encounter colorful butterflies and various bird species while your local guide will also introduce several tropical plants traditionally used by indigenous communities for herbal medicine, as well as types of wood commonly used for hunting tools and building local traditional houses. Later in the day, there is also an opportunity to observe the King Bird of Paradise (*Cicinnurus Regius*) or also known as Angry Bird, which can often be found not far from the base camp. In the evening free program while enjoy the serenity of the rainforest.



Visit 3 Rainforest of Paradise – Sorong (B/L/D)

After breakfast will venture deeper into the rainforest in search of the remarkable Twelve-Wired Bird of Paradise (*Seleucidis melanoleucus*). Along the trail, we will observe various insects, birds, reptiles, snakes and marsupials that inhabit this rich lowland ecosystem. Keep an eye out for wild jungle flowers, which often attract colorful butterflies searching for nectar. After lunch, we will return to the main road where the 4WD jeep will be waiting to us back to Sorong. Check in to hotel and free program later dinner at local restaurant at the heart of the Sorong City.

Visit 4 Sorong Local Market (B/-/-)

After breakfast then check out where we will have a short stop at local market in Sorong where you can see how locals trade before leaving to the airport for the next destination.



BALIEM VALLEY WAR FESTIVAL (5D4N)

Day 1 Wamena Town (-/L/D)

Upon arrival in Wamena Town, you will be warmly welcomed by your guide and driver at the airport and transferred to your hotel that conveniently located in the center of town. Situated at an altitude of approximately 1,850 meters, Wamena offers a pleasantly cool climate and serves as the gateway to the scenic Baliem Valley that part of Jayawijaya mountains region. After lunch, we will do a short city tour with a visit to a vibrant local market, where vendors sell fresh tropical fruits, vegetables, traditional goods, handmade crafts to live stocks such as pigs, which hold significant cultural and ceremonial value for the local communities. The tour continues with a visit to a local coffee plantation to learn about the cultivation and preparation of Papua's distinctive coffee. One of six Indonesian most favorite coffee. Afterwards, travel to nearby traditional villages where you will gain insight into the culture and daily life of the indigenous Dani Tribe, whose traditions and customs have been preserved for generations despite the gradual influence of modern life. In the evening back to the hotel and free program, dinner at the hotel restaurant.

Day 2 Dani Tribe Village (B/L/D)

After breakfast at the hotel, we will explore the southern part of the Baliem Valley, known for its scenic landscapes and traditional highland villages. The trek takes you across the Baliem River through the village of the Dani Tribe, where here we can see how the locals grow crops such as sweet potatoes, corn, and other local produce are cultivated on the hillsides. Sign of how local communities live largely self-sufficient lives, relying on their gardens and farms for daily sustenance. You may also encounter villagers from other part of the mountains traveling by foot kilometers away and carrying their harvests to sell at local market, a testament to their resilience and strong connection to the land. During the journey, you will have the opportunity to participate in a traditional Bakar Batu ceremony, a communal cooking tradition of the Dani people where food such as sweet potatoes, vegetables, and pork are cooked together using heated stones in an earth oven. This is a sign of gratitude and welcome ceremony for guests by the local community. This cultural experience offers a deeper insight into the social traditions and communal spirit of the local communities, making the trek through the Baliem Valley both a scenic and meaningful cultural adventure. Along the way you can also see numbers of bird of paradise including Snow Mountain Robin (*Petroica Archboldi*), King of Saxony Bird (*Pteridophora Alberti*) and many more return back to the hotel in the afternoon and free program. Dinner at local restaurant in town.

Day 3 & Day 4 Baliem Festival (B/L/D)

The **Baliem Valley Festival** is one of the most remarkable cultural events in Papua, held annually in the Baliem Valley near Wamena. Originally created to preserve local traditions and promote peaceful cultural expression,



the festival brings together several highland tribes, including the Dani, Lani, and Yali people. Over the course of two exciting days, visitors will witness dramatic mock tribal battles that recreate traditional warfare rituals once practiced between villages. These performances are carefully choreographed cultural demonstrations rather than real conflicts, allowing guests to experience the powerful history and warrior traditions of the highland communities. The participants wear traditional attire, including feathered headdresses, body paint, and traditional weapons such as spears, bows, and arrows, creating a vibrant and unforgettable spectacle.

Beyond the battles performance, the festival also features traditional music, tribal dances, pig feasts, and cultural performances that showcase the rich heritage of the Baliem Valley tribes. Guests can expect an immersive cultural experience, with opportunities to observe traditional crafts, interact with local villagers, and photograph one of the most unique cultural gatherings in Indonesia. The atmosphere is lively and colorful, with hundreds of participants from different villages gathering in full ceremonial dress. For visitors, the Baliem Festival offers a rare chance to witness living traditions of Papua's highland cultures while enjoying the spectacular mountain scenery of the Baliem Valley.

Day 5 The Mummy of Jiwika & Kontilola Cave (B/L/D)

Today you will visit Jiwika Village, a traditional Dani settlement in the Baliem Valley known for preserving one of Papua's most remarkable cultural relics, a 250-year-old tribal mummy. The mummy, believed to belong to a former Dani Tribe chief and respected warrior. Carefully preserved by the local community and represents an important symbol of ancestral heritage and leadership. This visit offers a rare opportunity to learn about Dani history and traditions directly from the villagers. Afterwards, the journey continues to Kontilola Cave, a fascinating natural site surrounded by lush forest. After a short climb along moss-covered rocks and steps, you will reach the cave entrance where you can explore its interior, admire impressive stalactites and stalagmites, and observe bats resting in the cave's dark chambers. Inside, ancient wall paintings can also be seen high on the cave ceiling where due to this painting many debates have sparkle if it is a potrait of aliens or spiritual being providing insight into the region's cultural past. There is also an underground river flowing beneath the cave adds to the unique and mystical atmosphere of this natural wonder. Back to hotel in the afternoon and free program.

Day 6 Wamena Aiport (B/-/-)

After check out drop to the Wamena airport to catch outbound flight.
